DIOCESAN STAFF

Effective January 1, 1976, the retirement age for all personnel of the Diocese of Nova Scotia will be 65 years.

Resignations will be considered to be automatically submitted at the end of the month in which the person's 65th birthday occurs.

Appointments will be renewable for one-year periods following the age of 65 years.

Any renewal will be with the consent of the Diocesan Bishop and the Parish involved, and that the Human Resources Committee be informed.
