

Appendix A (Guideline 2.2.11)

A housing allowance shall be based on the following parameters:

The minimum square footage for the home should be 2000 square feet. (While not a rectory, it is reasonable to assume that parish gatherings/meetings may be held at the Rector's residence. Therefore, there should be adequate space to accommodate this.)

The home should have a minimum of four (4) bedrooms, or three (3) bedrooms, one (1) study.

The home should have a minimum one (1) full bathroom and one half (1/2) bathroom.

All liveable areas of the home are finished. ("Liveable areas" is defined as any space with a seven (7) foot, plus, ceiling height.)

The home should include the following appliances: Fridge, Stove, and Dishwasher.

Should be situated on a piece of land that measures at least 6,000 square feet.

SPECIAL CLAUSE: *If a parish that pays a housing allowance adjusted their figures according to the Guideline 2.2.11 when it came into affect on January 1, 2005, they may not reduce this figure according to the new amended guideline. However, they are not required to adjust their housing allowance again until the current figure falls short of a new figure calculated according to the above parameters. The need to make this adjustment will become evident at a bi-annually review as per section "C" of this guideline.*
