April 2, 10:00 am, **Stations of the Cross**, especially suitable for children  
12:00-3:00 pm The Three Hour Service, includes beautiful music and meditations on **Christ's Seven Last Words from the Cross** by Dr. David Deane of the Atlantic School of Theology.

### EASTER EVE – THE GREAT VIGIL & FIRST MASS OF EASTER

April 3, 11:00 pm, we come together for the great **Vigil & First Mass of Easter**. We begin in darkness and end in the Divine Light. We enter the Mystery.

April 4, **Holy Communion** is said at 8:00 am; **Choral Holy Communion** takes place at 10:30 am, with glorious music accompanied by brass and drums. We gather to receive the risen Christ in the Sacrament and to know him in community.
