CANON 26 CANDIDATES FOR HOLY ORDERS

- 1. Before the Bishop accepts a person for Holy Orders, the person must have complied with the Guidelines respecting Ordination as established, from time to time, by the House of Bishops of the Anglican Church of Canada
- 2. The Admission of an applicant to postulancy does not guarantee Ordination nor should it be taken as in any sense implying an assurance of employment.
- 3. An applicant for postulancy, who is also an applicant for stipendiary ordained ministry,

 1996 shall be required to satisfy the bishop, in a form and manner acceptable to the bishop, that he or she will be willing and able to take up residency in any parish in the diocese at the time when the initial appointment may be considered. The ability to meet and maintain such a requirement shall be a condition for obtaining and maintaining postulancy.
