CANON 4 THE CHANCELLOR OF THE DIOCESE

1. The Chancellor of the Diocese shall be a communicant of the Anglican Church of Canada, resident in the Diocese, and a judge of a court of record or a barrister-at-law of at least ten years standing.

2. The Chancellor shall be appointed by the Bishop and hold office during the Bishop's pleasure.

3. The Chancellor shall be ex officio a member of the Synod and ineligible to be elected to represent any parish as lay representative.

4. It shall be the duty of the Chancellor to advise the Bishop or any assistant Bishop or any Archdeacon on all legal matters pertaining to the Diocese submitted to him or her.

5. The Bishop may appoint a Vice-Chancellor who shall have the same qualifications, powers, duties and privileges as the Chancellor, and shall assist him or her and act in his or her place, in his or her absence or incapacity, or when requested by the Bishop or the Chancellor.
