## **2019 Clergy Minimum Stipend Scale is as follows:**

The "Base Year" is the calendar year that a priest enters the ministry for the first time. "Year 1" begins on the following January 1<sup>st</sup>.

"Years of Service" will mean years of service in Parish ministry or some affiliated Church sponsored service such as Chaplaincies or National Staff.

Credit for years of affiliated ministry may be granted upon approval by the Bishop.

\*Parishes may pay their clergy above the listed minimums (if they meet the above two conditions) but may not reduce the stipend if it is above the minimum listed for the appropriate years of service.

When two members of the clergy are married to each other, the salary compensation package for each shall consist of stipend plus housing (either a rectory or a housing allowance). (*See Housing Policy 2.2.11.*)
