
CHARITABLE TAX RECEIPT TIPS

E-GIVING: Another idea is to include information about **PAR** (Pre-Authorize Remittance) and/or **Canada Helps.** These are two easy, safe and fast ways to electronically support your missional endeavors. Some parishes include the PAR form itself, saving a few steps (the giver doesn't have to seek it out and the parish does not have to send it).
