The Anglican Church Women Diocesan Board will be ordering the Canadian Church Calendar 2022 for sale to the parishes. However, **it is also possible for parishes to order the Canadian Church Calendar 2022 directly from the Anglican Church of Canada (ACC)**. There are several benefits for parishes to consider ordering calendars through the ACC e-store. It is possible to secure **25 plus calendars at very good value and free shipping!** Placing an order with the ACC's e-store means that the order is pre-paid with **a credit card at the time of placing the order. Ordering is done on-line.**

If ordering through the Anglican Church Women Board, the order must be submitted via e-mail (acw.nsboard@gmail.com) only. Provide the name of the person ordering, the name of the Parish and its community, and the number of calendars being ordered. Payment must be submitted by cheque or money order (invoice # noted in the memo line) **before or at the time of pick-up***. Payments submitted before pick-up are to be sent to Marjorie Davis, 204 – 111 Peblecreek Drive, Dartmouth, NS B2W 0L1. *All payments to be submitted **no later than October 29, 2021, regardless of pick-up date.** Pick-up is at the Anglican Diocesan Centre, 1340 Cathedral Lane, Halifax, NS B3H 2Z1, **each Wednesday, September 29 – November 24, 1:00 – 2:30 pm** at the main entrance. Calendars are not mailed and are not able to be returned.
