## Canon 7, 3.

- (1) One of the clerical or lay delegates to General Synod shall be a resident of Prince Edward 1996 Island elected by the Assembly of the Diocesan Church Society of Prince Edward Island and confirmed as a delegate by resolution of Synod.
- (2) Prior to each Synod session for the election of General Synod delegates, the Secretary of the Diocesan Church Society of Prince Edward Island shall notify the bishop in writing of the name of the person elected as a delegate and the name of a person elected as a substitute delegate and confirm the persons elected have agreed to serve.
