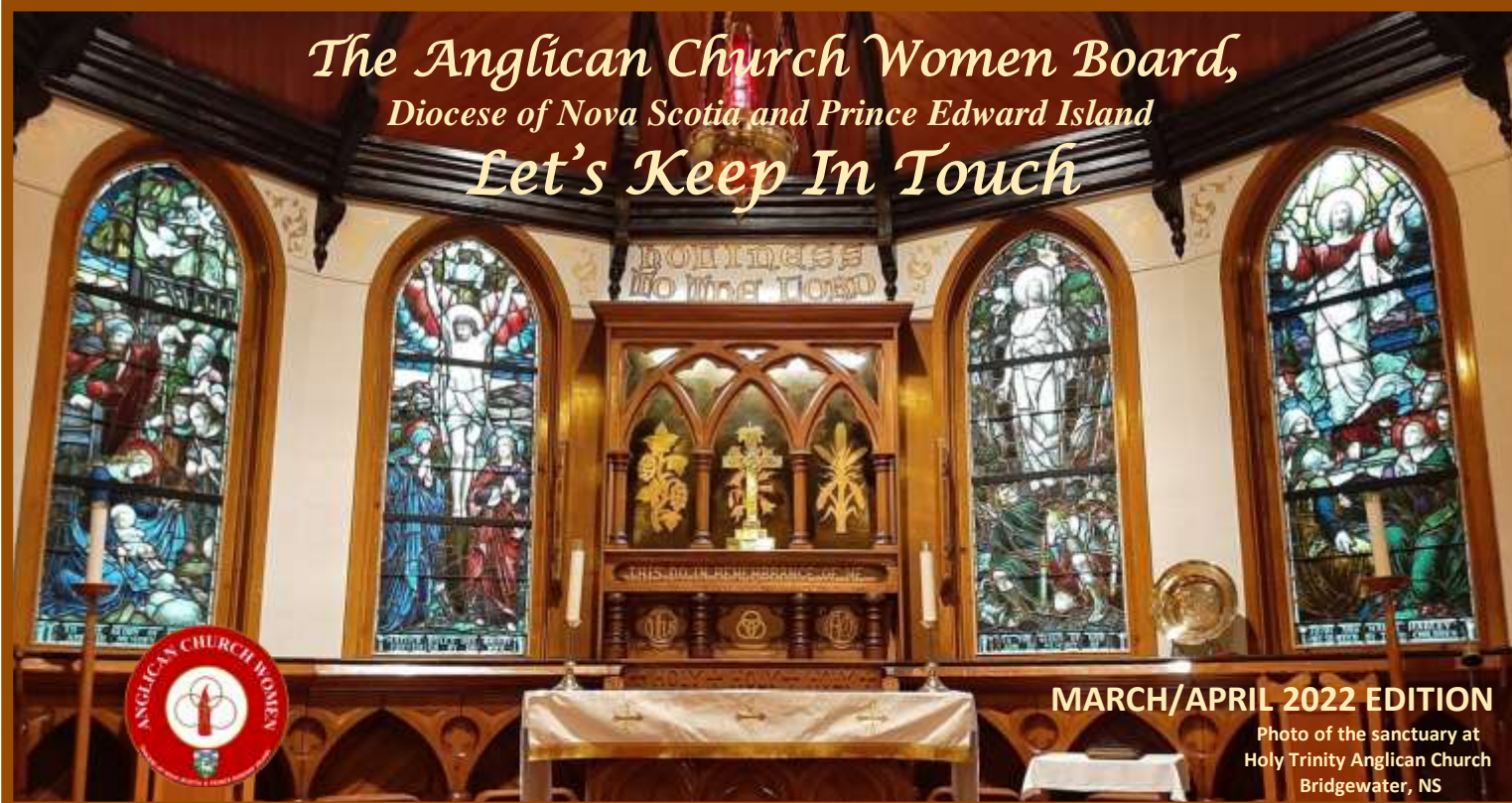

Say Yes! to Kids 2022 – Growing a brighter future, today

Anglican Church Women are being encouraged to advocate for the Anglican Foundation of Canada's (AFC's) *Say Yes! to Kids 2022 – Growing a brighter future, today*. Why? Well: 1. Anglican Church Women have an historic and current interest in supporting kids, youth, and family ministry at both the Board and parish levels; and, 2. Anglican Church Women have historic and current success as consummate fundraisers in support of the mission of the church. These two features make Anglican Church Women great champions and 'cheer leaders' for AFC'S *Say Yes! to Kids 2022 – Anglican women want our parishes and diocese to benefit from the Foundation's fundraising expertise in support of kids, youth, and young adults. After all, fundraising is the Foundation's ministry!*

What is *Say Yes! to Kids 2022 – Growing a brighter future, today*?

- A fundraising approach of the Anglican Foundation in **support of kids, youth, and young adults** that is known as **Person-to-Person (P2P) fundraising**. It is fun and effective.
- A way to generate funds to support kids, youth, and young adults' ministry in the parish, diocese, and the Anglican Church of Canada (ACC) nationally, with a **partnership sharing model**.

How does the partnership model of AFC's *Say Yes! to Kids 2022* work?

- The partnership model means **that 60%** of the funds that the parish raises are **returned to the parish** for the already identified project (and for which the P2P Team was created); **20% to the Diocese of NS & PEI** for the diocesan youth project (likely the *Community Roots Camp* enterprise); and **20%** stays with **AFC** for the national project (likely an Indigenous youth leadership development project). All funds raised are directed to the benefit of kids and youth.
- The Parish P2P Team is registered with the Foundation and **all technical aspects of the P2P approach, including receipts, are managed by AFC and Canada Helps**. This is a huge benefit.

Why register an AFC *Say Yes! to Kids 2022* P2P Team at your parish? And why now?

- Allow your parish to **Imagine More** for the benefit of kids and youth in the parish and community.
- **Embrace the P2P approach** to experience the effectiveness and ease of P2P fundraising.
- Have your parish benefit from the exceptional **one-on-one mentoring, marketing, and case development support of AFC**.
- Benefit from what AFC is able to leverage by way of **leadership gifts and matching funds**. For example, AFC is finalizing plans to have the first \$1,000 raised by the first 50 Parish P2P Teams Canada-wide be matched. So, that means \$2,000 automatically!! Don't delay! Register a team.
