WHO THEY ARE

Worship Leaders at DYC are folks who are deeply rooted in their faith and are excited to invite youth and leaders at DYC to worship together and grow in their faith. They know what discipleship is all about, and how to offer worship experiences that are transformational, and how to invite young people in to help shape their own worship experiences.

WHAT THEY DO

Worship Leaders plan and lead worship for the weekend of DYC, usually opening worship on Friday evening, morning and evening prayer on Saturday, and Eucharist on Sunday. They choose and lead songs and put together liturgies that bring the theme to life and invite participants to draw near to God.

WHAT SPECIAL SKILLS ARE HELPFUL

Generally we have at least one worship leader who is a priest and one who is skilled at leading music (with or without musical accompaniment). Beyond those things, creativity, excellent communication skills, and flexibility are all super helpful.

WHAT YOUR WEEKEND WILL LOOK LIKE

If being a worship leader is your only role, then the weekend is pretty chill. You'll prepare for worship, make sure everything is set up and ready to go, lead worship, and then be as present as you'd like to what's happening in the weekend until you prepare for the next time of worship. If you've got an additional role as well, that will obviously change things, but we'll always make sure that you've got the time that you need to prepare for worship.
